# Black Comedy Director's Notes

Given that this is my first outing as a fully-fledged director - preferring to engage in a kind of infuriating back-seat directing while hiding behind the title of producer - I could have chosen an easier project to start with. Farce is never easy and, to make it funny, even less so. Add to that the complication of having the cast pretend to not be able to see, while engaging in all manner of physical prat falls, and the task seems even tougher. I think they cope with doors, lights and furniture incredibly well and I, too, can't wait to tell them... 'Darlings, you were wonderful!' If someone would just give me some light please!

#### Jamie Scott - Brindsley Miller

Whilst known among certain friends as the 'Dark Lord' Jamie is delighted for the opportunity to appear in a farce and make people laugh at me (or should that be with me?). For those of you concerned that his demeanour is changing, rest assured he will be back in Dark Lord mood later in the year appearing as Sykes in Oliver!

#### Matilda James - Carol Melkett

Matilda was really excited to have the opportunity of being a part of Black Comedy. She feels the rehearsal process has been a fantastic experience for her and she has found learning the lines quickly (she only took on the part three weeks ago!) and acting as though in the dark a real challenge.
