The men live in an area devastated by unemployment and have not only lost their jobs but some of their humanity too. As in Macbeth, their world has been turned upside down. Wives work and husbands sit at home. Soon the men will become the commodities and the women the consumers. Although the play is set in Buffalo, New York and not in the north of England as in the excellent film it is based on, the challenges and emotions faced by the characters are just as vital. Unemployment is unemployment wherever it is.


